Welcome to our June issue of the Community Impact newsletter! This monthly newsletter provides important updates about our Building Our Future (BOF) project which includes our new global headquarters in downtown Cleveland and our new global research & development (R&D) center in Brecksville, Ohio.

We are excited to be building our future here in Northeast Ohio, the region we have called home for more than 156 years and the region we will continue supporting in the many years to come.

Over the course of this \$600 million, multi-year project, our goals are to award a minimum of \$90 million to minority-owned businesses, \$42 million to female-owned businesses, and \$48 million to small businesses for a total commitment of at least \$180 million.
