Project Scope

Project Locations:

- Downtown Cleveland Global Headquarters (West of Public Square between St. Clair and Superior)
- City of Brecksville R&D Center
 (Located off of I-77 at Miller Road and Brecksville Road)

Project Details:

- Global Headquarters Approximately 1,000,000 SF
- R&D Center Approximately 600,000 SF

Project Schedule:

- R&D start of construction celebration October 22, 2021
- HQ start of construction celebration January 28, 2022
- Transition to new facilities expected by end of 2024

Integrated Project Delivery (IPD) and Major Trade Partners

- Effectively and efficiently deliver the project
- Highly collaborative with designers working closely with builders throughout the project
- Integrates builders throughout the project, instead of a single "bid day"
- As the project progresses, builders are given the opportunity to bid and be awarded work
- The opportunity to obtain work under IPD is equal to any other project delivery system







Integrated Project Delivery and Major Trade Partners (MTP)

- Includes trade-specific construction management
- Offers opportunities for subcontract award via lump sum, cost-plus, etc.
- Follows the same procurement processes as Welty | Gilbane for buyout and award of all work
- Provides a variety of opportunities based on the scope of work managed by MTPs

- Engage in the community to share project opportunities
- Work to leverage community partnerships
- Target outreach to certified enterprises within Northeast Ohio
- Track business and workforce compliance

 - MBE & FBE Combined 30%

\$225M total diverse spend based on a minimum \$750M project construction cost

Workforce Project Goals

- Minority 16%
- Female 7%
- Cleveland residents (HQ only) 20%*

Northeast Ohio Project Goals

- Enterprise 50% of profits will remain in NE Ohio
- Workforce 90% of labor will be NE Ohio based






